

CRITERIA FOR EXCLUSION FROM (NAME OF BUSINESS)

- 1) The subject is in and/or upon the property/premises when the business located there is closed and the individual is not otherwise authorized to be there.
- 2) The subject is found in an area of the property/premises which is not open to the public and he/she is not authorized to be there.
- 3) The subject engages in any activity which constitutes a criminal offense.
- 4) The subject makes unreasonable noise.
- 5) The subject enters and/or remains on the property/premises and interferes with the rights, comfort, or conveniences of the owner, tenants, patrons and guests.
- 6) The subject consumes and/or possesses an open container of alcoholic beverage on the property/premises.
- 7) The subject camps, urinates, litters, or otherwise remains in/and upon the property/premises without a discernable legitimate purpose.
- 8) The subject violates the State Curfew Statute 419c.680.

Any person who fails to leave the property after being directed to do so, or who returns to the property after being given such direction, will be subject to arrest and prosecution for Criminal Trespass under ORS 164.245.
